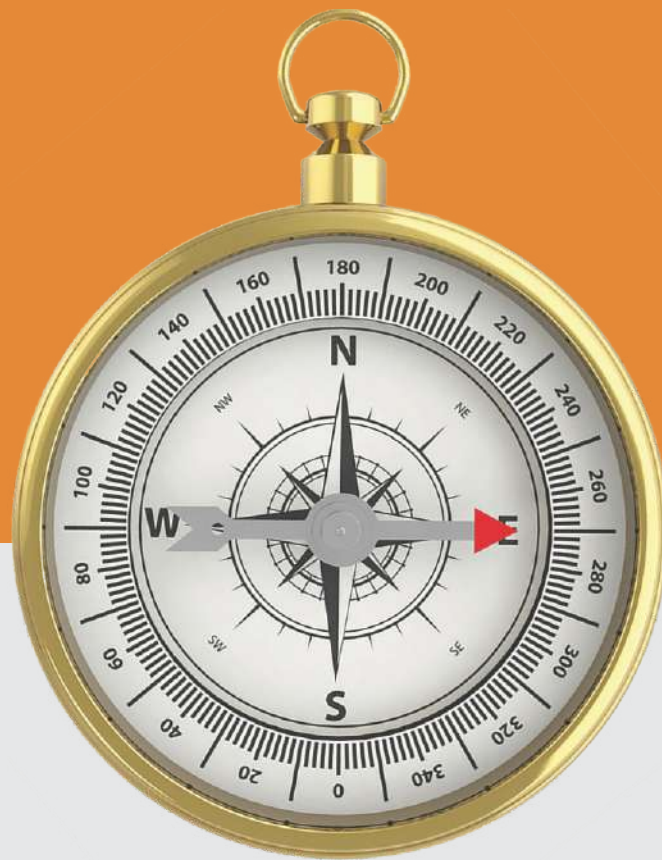

The Program of Georgian Philology equips the students with the knowledge which enables them to create successful career; provides them with the knowledge of interdisciplinary issues related to general humanitarian and philological sciences; develops the skills of critical analysis of literary works, discussing them in historical and cultural scope, commenting and interpretation; teaches the structure of the Georgian Language and History; gives adequate knowledge of the English language for successful communication; helps the in-depth envisage of the Georgian literature and culture in the context of the European civilization.

The Program of English Philology trains a bachelor equipped with interdisciplinary knowledge, able to perform professional activity not only in philological, but other adjacent fields, such as Politics and International Relations, Mass Communication, etc. The program graduate will be a qualified professional, having competence relevant to general humanitarian scope on the one hand, and effective English speaking communicator on the other, whose language competence encompasses the skill of applying general and professional languages (Business, Politics, Law).

The objective of **the Program of Oriental Studies** (in Arabic / Persian/ Turkish languages) is to train a professional orientalist/region expert; with the qualified knowledge of one of the oriental languages (Arabic, Persian, Turkish);

The program gives profound knowledge about the culture and system of the history, economics, politics, religion and law of the Middle East; with the consideration of its current state and prospects, the characteristics of the countries in the region, the dynamics of historical relations with Georgia and the countries within the region.

The objective of **the Program of History** (Georgian/World) is to train a qualified specialist in the sciences of history; giving profound knowledge about the history of Georgia and the world from ancient times up to present considering social-political, economic, legal and cultural aspects. The program aims at molding a citizen with high social awareness and democratic values, ready to understand and respect diverse cultures; flexible individual equipped with analytical, critical and communicational skills.

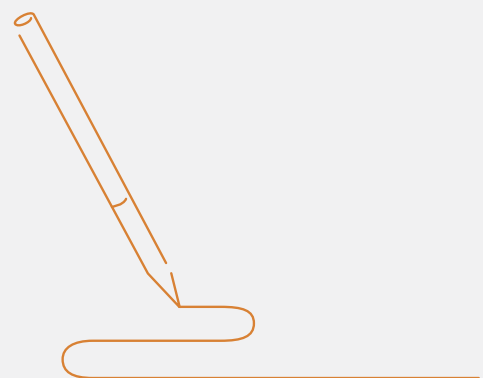
**The Program of Art** promotes the study, preservation and presentation of rich cultural heritage of the country through training of the experts of art with qualified high competence and professional skills; they will possess the skills necessary to succeed in the field of art research. 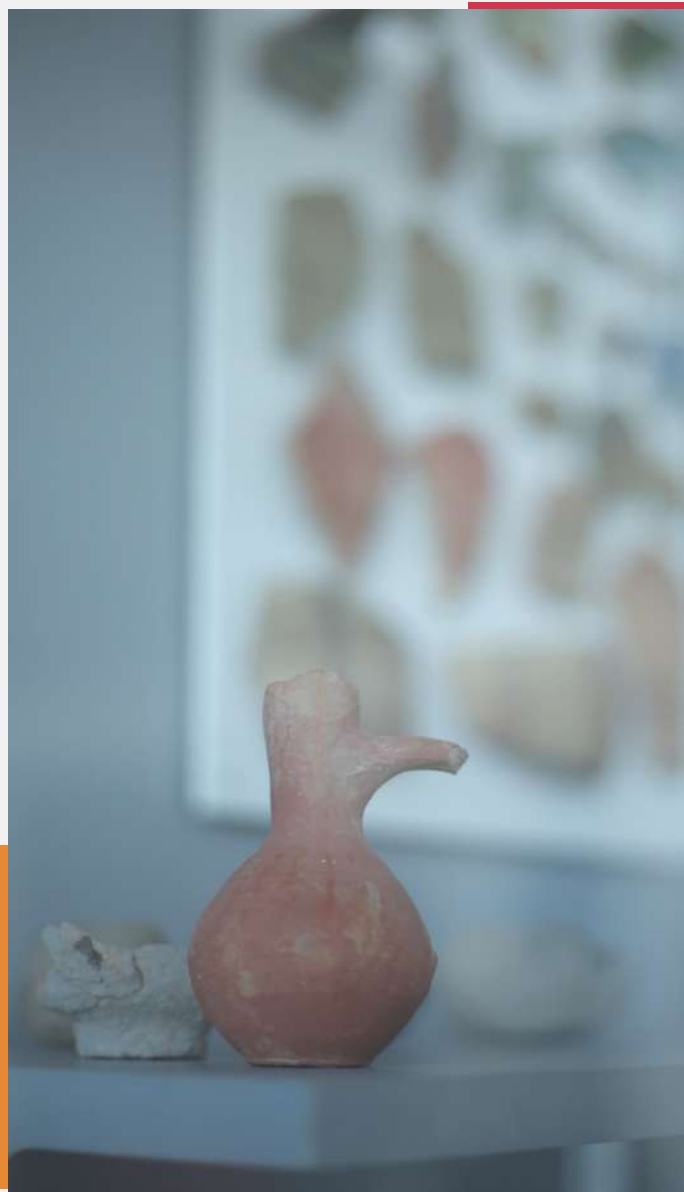
**English Philology** for International Students. The objective of the program is to train a qualified specialist with the ability to communicate effectively in the English language. The skills developed after the completion of the program offer the student the opportunities to be employed in publishing houses, in the mass communication systems and in companies seeking for the professionals with English language communication skills. According to the challenges and demands of the labor market the program has integrated the subjects that are useful for developing the necessary competences in English language studies.

**MA Program of Archaeology** trains high qualified specialists in archaeology, providing extensive knowledge about main archeological monuments and culture of Georgia, the Near East and the program develops the skills world. The program also of planning and managing archeological expeditions independently and professional outcome evaluation. Besides, the trains the graduate students for PhD studies and helps them in becoming professional archeologists.

The aim of the Program of Archaeology is to prepare the archaeologists with the market oriented qualifications, modern standards and professional/practical skills, able to study, preserve, present, contribute to the cultural heritage of the country and to achieve success in the field with consideration of modern principles of research. The objective of **English Philology Master's Program** is to train a highly qualified specialist. The theoretical and practical knowledge gained throughout the program gives the graduate the competences in both philological and applied aspects of the English language. The program trains a Philologist who will be able to contribute to the cultural dialogue as well as the integration process of Georgia with English speaking countries. The subjects within the program, oriented on developing the skills necessary for professional communications, greatly widens the Philological competences and enhances the chances of employment both in the local and international labor markets for the graduates.



**Georgian History Master's Program** trains a highly qualified specialist with practical skills; equipped with knowledge in the history of Georgia; capable of working independently on the Georgian and English sources; possessing the ability to conduct research independently using the update methods; having the skills necessary for working in the multidisciplinary environment.

The objective of **Education Administration Master's Program** is to equip the student with the knowledge of managing educational system, develop leadership and professional skills, be aware of issues and challenges of teaching, so that the student is able to take a global position in the field of education; to understand and analyze the theories and practices of the field consistent with modern researches and professional experiences.

**Georgian Philology Master's Program** trains a highly qualified student in Georgian Philology (Language and Literature); Curriculum and the literature used for studies equip the graduate with the professional competences and skills required for scientific research that are highly demanded on a labor market.

**English Philology PhD Program** aims to coach a qualified specialist who will have an interdisciplinary fundamental knowledge of the latest achievements of the field, competence of scientific research for teaching and scientific research, being able to conduct a research of a language within the various linguistic theories and analyze research outcomes on the one hand, and share the knowledge gained within the PhD Program on the other.

# RESOURCES

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## Hall of Iran



is equipped with modern learning/scientific literature, offering the opportunity of watching Iranian TV channels, with the support of the Embassy of the Iran Islamic Republic. All these allow the students to acquire knowledge of Iran and eventually develop the Persian Language skills.

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## Language Laboratory



is designed for 150 students to work simultaneously. The lab is equipped with the modern programs for language teaching and contributes to broaden the knowledge of English and eastern languages by applying specially-designed linguistic programs.

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## International Center of Archaeology



International Center of Archaeology carries out active and efficient activities to popularize and commercialize the archaeological disciplines. The Center has already organized tours to the archaeological base of the University of Georgia in Samshilde and different archaeological expeditions within Georgia. The Center offers organized archaeological tours and archaeological summer school for the Georgian and International students to better understand the cultural heritage of Georgia.

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## Archaeological Exhibition/Museum



UG Archaeological Exhibition has the status of the University Museum where artifacts discovered by Samshilde archeological expedition are preserved and prepared for expositions. At the same time, the museum/ exhibition is used by the students of appropriate specialties to develop professional skills (material management, preparation of appropriate texts, organizing exhibitions) and promotes and enhances professional /practical skills.

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## Archaeological Base and Expedition of the University



The University has a well-equipped archaeological base on the territory of Samshilde where the students and the academic staff involved in the field can implement professional activities; The base allows primary processing of the obtained archaeological material. The archaeological expedition of the University is equipped with the latest European and American archaeological facilities and is provided with all conditions necessary for the field work. The archaeological expedition conducts scientific researches in Samshilde Nakalakari where students of relevant specialties (Archaeology, History, Art, Computer Technologies, and Tourism) participate. It represents the basis for enhancing the professional and practical skills for students.

The Bachelor's Program of Political Science comprises the modern theories, approaches and major political tendencies. The students will be taught the principles of state structure and its functioning, political processes and actions, interconnection of state and community. The graduates will have an opportunity to be employed in state structures, international and non-governmental organizations, etc.

# BE A FORCE FOR POSITIVE CHANGE

**Bachelor's Program of Journalism** is designed in consistency with the requirements of the employment market. The program enables the students to learn the following: story telling techniques based on journalism data, using multimedia techniques, preparing and covering the news, writing in-depth analytical articles, preparing coverage and documentaries, recording interviews, taking photos, filming videos, making montage, covering business, political, healthcare and environmental issues.

Students undertake internships in different media companies; at the same time they work at UG Newsroom. The program is a member of the European Journalism Training Association (EJTA) within the scope of which students participate in exchange programs, international assemblies and student conferences. Our graduates work in the leading media organizations, media agencies and televisions among them.

Within the **Bachelor's Program of Strategic Communications** the students develop the skills necessary for employment, namely: development and management of the strategies of social media, elaboration and implementation of PR plan; research implementation, development of the strategy of integrated marketing communications, establishing relations with media, brand making, creation of multimedia projects. In order to develop practical skills, students pass internship in various PR consulting and strategic communications services. At the same time, UG PR CONSULTING operates on the base of the University where students work out communication strategies for real companies, plan different events and work with media. Graduates are employed in their professional scope and work in the leading companies of Georgia. The Program of Strategic Communications is a member of the European Association (EUPRERA) what enables students to be actively involved in exchange programs, participate in international assemblies and student conferences.

**The Bachelor's Degree Program of International Relations** comprises the issues of international security, politics and economics, the modern system of international relations, the various theories and schools of international relations, the issues of globalization and the latest international challenges, international law, the problems concerning international organizations justice, international organizations, regional integration, military power, terrorism, international trade, the issues of international finances, the interaction of state and non-state factors, the problems of decision making in foreign policy, geopolitics, the issues of geo-economics and geo-strategy.

In theoretical and practical context, **Bachelor's Program of Psychology** matches with the international standards and meets the requirements of the labor market. The program aims to prepare competent, qualified and multi-skilled psychologists who acquire basic qualification in the principle fields of psychology: social psychology, personality, education and development, clinical psychology, labor and organization psychology. In addition, research component is one of the strengths of the program. Students pass internship in different state and private organizations, in HR Management services, at schools and kindergartens (UG kindergarten and UG school among them), training centers, research organizations, consulting and rehabilitation centers, "Contact" - the Center for Psychological Services and Analysis at the Department of Psychology at the University. Graduates can conduct their professional activities in the field of professional employment within professional ethics.

Considering the local and international market requirements, the **Master's Program of Applied Psychology** prepares highly qualified professionals and awards them the qualification in the following fields: child and adolescent psychology, clinical psychology, industrial and organizational psychology. The goal of the Master's Program of Applied Psychology is, considering the regularities of the events ongoing in the society and following the professional ethical norms, to equip a graduate with the knowledge about conducting research and professional practical work independently in the following fields of psychology: child and adolescent psychology; clinical psychology; applied psychology.

**Master's Program of Public Relations and Advertising** consists of several concentrations: international setup; international security and foreign policy; regions and regional geography. The program teaches students international security and international economic and political issues; modern systems of international relations;

significant theories and schools of international relations; problems of globalization and the latest international law; problems of international organizations and implementation of international justice; regional integration; issues of military force, terrorism, international trade and international finances; interaction of state and non-state factors; problems of making foreign policy decisions; issues of geopolitics, geo-economics and geo-statistics.

**International Relations Master's Program** teaches the students main theoretical approaches to global politics, enabling them to generalize and analyze the current problems of international politics including the regional and trans-regional politics. The students will also gain knowledge and skills that will help them in pursuing modern foreign policy. Specifically:

- the knowledge of energy policy and energy security topics in the country, region and globally;
- the ability to find new original ways for negotiations and to plan business meetings in order to resolve different complex political problems;
- the ability to form a hypothesis within the Caucasus global politics and to conduct a research independently;
- the ability to make decisions according to the current difficult political events and evaluation of social-economic situation.

The objective of **Political Science PhD Program (In Georgian and English Languages)** is designed to help the students in creating and developing new knowledge in the fields of political science. The program trains experts of Political Science who will take part in developing the country's democracy and thus serve the public, country and the world. The objective of the program is to equip the graduate with the innovative theoretical knowledge, research methods and data analysis knowledge after the completion of the entire learning process, scientific component course and the dissertation. The PhD graduate will also be able to prepare and conduct innovative scientific projects about the current problems of political science applying the newest standards of project management.

Within the **PhD Program of Mass Communication** graduates acquire the skills necessary for a researcher. They will be able to plan and conduct research independently in order to create new scientific knowledge, prepare articles for high-rank international scientific journals. The program is a member of the European PR Association what enables students to participate in exchange programs, international assemblies and student conferences, be actively involved in different international research projects.

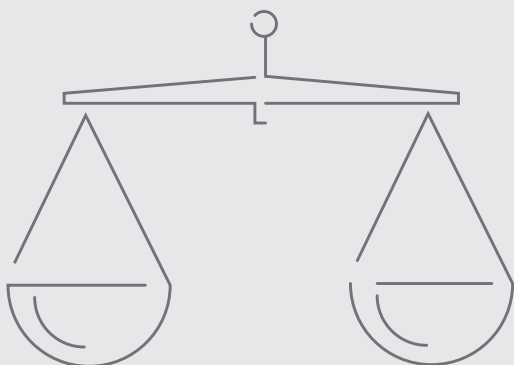

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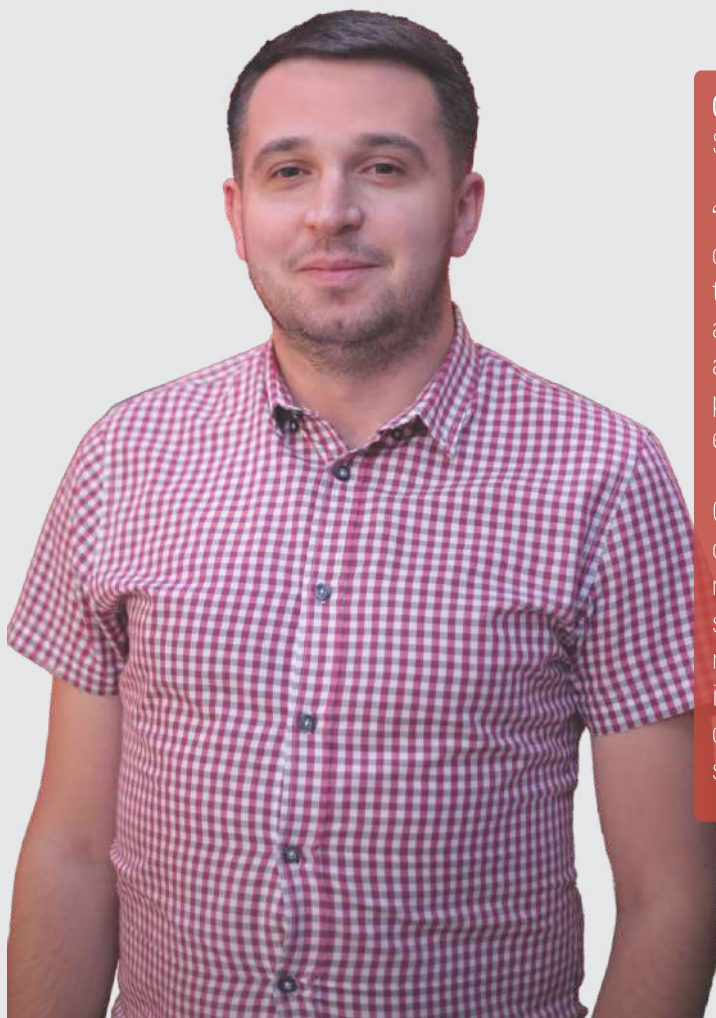
**SCHOOL OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY**

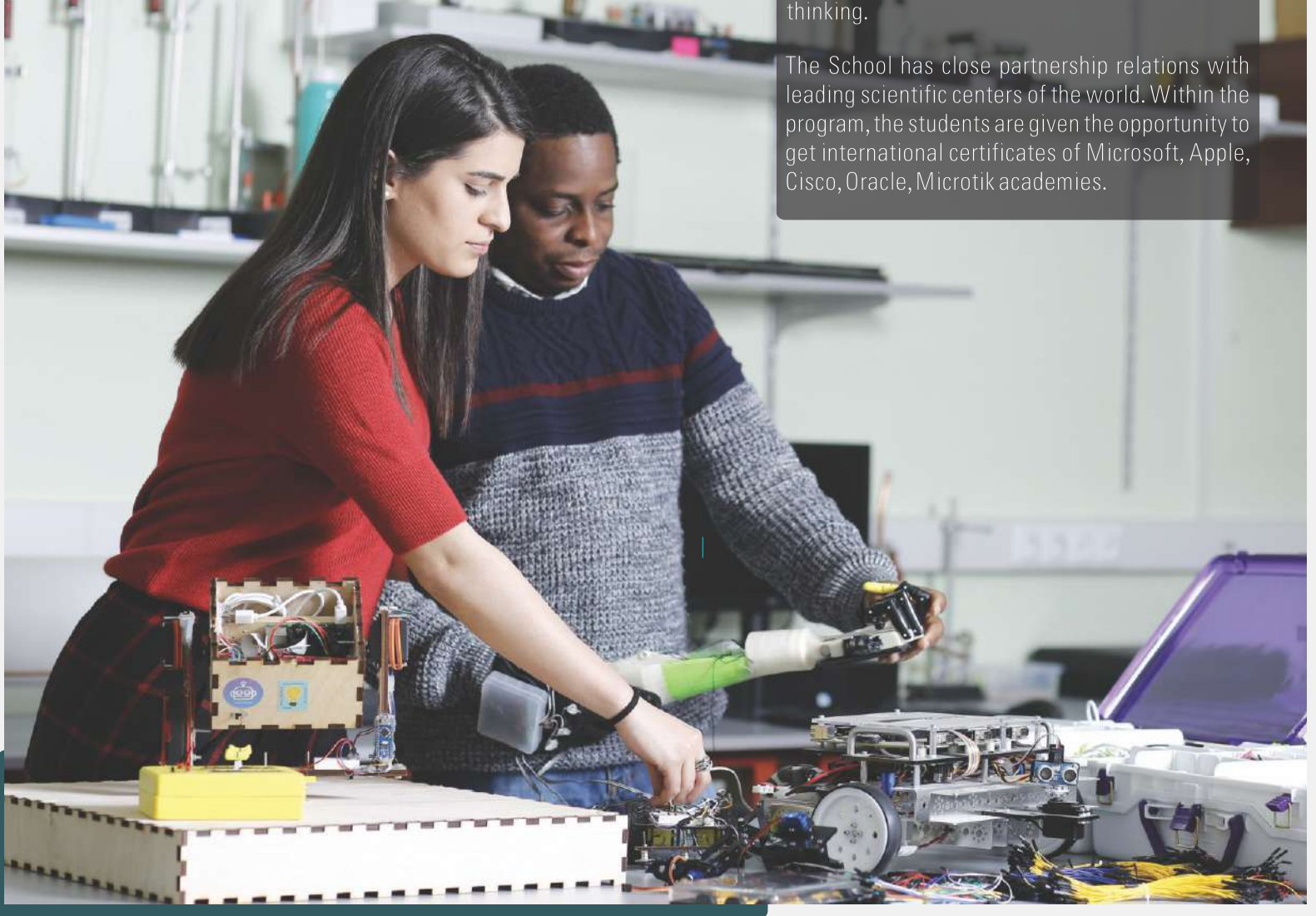

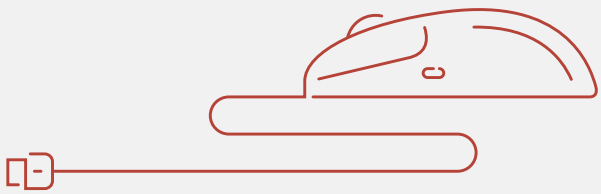

**The Program of Electrical and Computer Engineering** will enable the students to study the basics of higher mathematics, physics and computer sciences. The program will help to develop the skills of projecting and realization of electrical components, systems and processes, designing simple software code, analysis of theoretical and quantitative outcomes of solving the problems in maths and physics and innovative thinking in engineering. The students will learn the issues of robotics and electronics starting from simple electronic schemes to complex functional programmable schemes. The graduates of the Program of Electrical and Computer Engineering will be employed in telecommunication and computer companies, governmental organizations, banks and other private companies, where the competence in the fields of electronics, telecommunication, radio and computer engineering is needed.

**Engineering Bachelor's Program in English** includes computer and electronic engineering fields. The aim of the program is to equip the students with the knowledge that is suitable for modern demand and to help him/her develop practical skills in computer and electronic engineering. The program includes higher mathematics and physics courses, basics of programming, computer networks (Cisco CCNA courses), basics of mobile communications, antennas and robotics.

After completing the course, the student will have the theoretical knowledge and practical skills necessary for employment in public and private organizations.



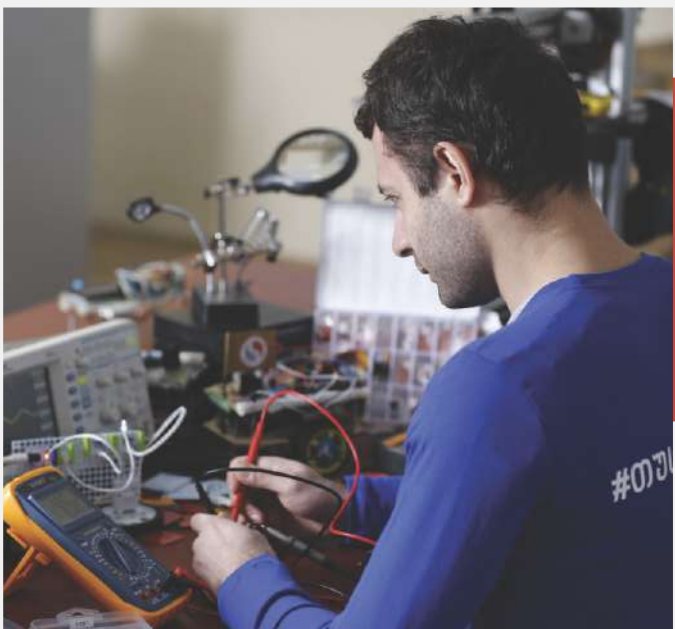

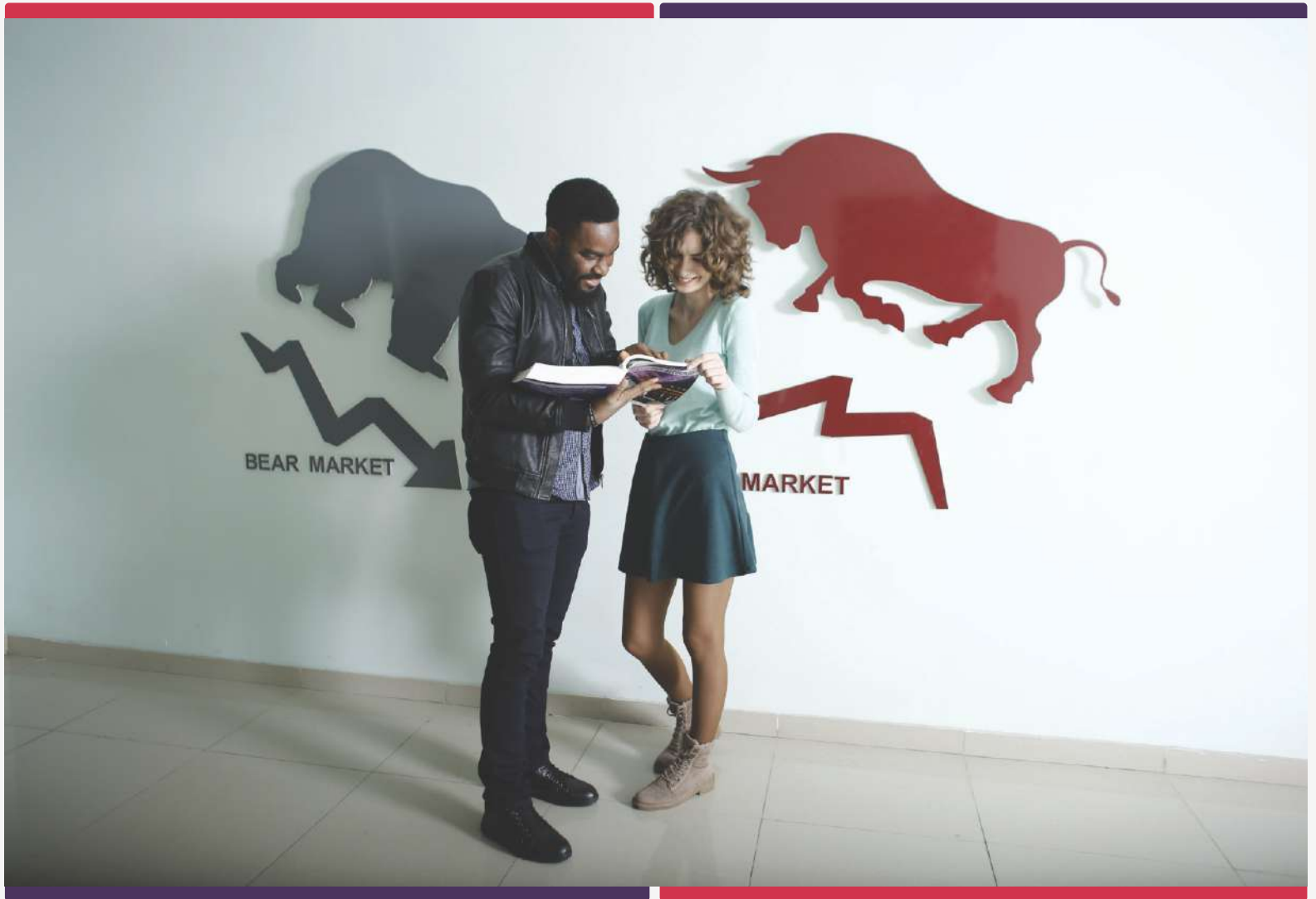

He/She will be able to develop goals and strategies for healthcare policy, carry out these strategies and evaluate the results. The students have access to international and exchange programs of the school in USA, Norway, Turkey and various countries of Europe. The program includes the newest study material in the English language in hard copies as well as electronic versions. The students will also be able to participate in scientific conferences, publish their research findings in the international journal of the University.

The aim of the **Pharmacy MA Program** is to train a highly qualified specialist equipped with the thorough and systematic knowledge, who will be able to adequately respond to the global and local challenges concerning medical pharmacology, clinical pharmacy, rational pharmacotherapy, clinical toxicology, patient oriented pharmaceutical care, appropriate pharmaceutical practice and clinical researches in the field of practical and clinical pharmacy. The students have an opportunity to participate in scientific conferences, to publish their own research outcomes in UG journal - "Caucasus Journal of Health and Sciences and Public Health". The program provides the student with hard copies as well as electronic versions of the latest literature and scientific articles in English language. The students have access to the International and Exchange programs of the school. GMP and AVERSI pharmaceutical companies and clinics will be accessible for practical training.

The aim of the **MA Program of Health Care Administration** is to coach qualified administrators/managers of the Health care system, whose professional activities will promote the growth of effectiveness of health care system in order to improve health and well-being of society. The graduate students will have deep knowledge of health care system, regarding the management of each segment and health care organizations. He/She will be able to evaluate external and internal factors having impact on system/organization, research of the problem, to make conclusions and decision based on the evidences and to take appropriate actions. The MA Program gives the students the opportunity of implementing a high level managerial activities in the private or public sectors of health care system, in health insurance or pharmaceutical companies, also in local or international non-governmental health care organizations.

There are International projects and Exchange Programs in USA, Norway, Turkey and various countries in Europe available for students. There is modern literature in English and their online versions, with scientific articles provided within the program. The students have an opportunity to participate in scientific conferences, publish their own research outcomes in UG Journal - "Caucasus Journal of Health and Sciences and Public Health".

The goal of the **single-cycle Dental program in English** is to coach qualified dentists with a modern competitive diploma on an international level. The program envisages preparation of dentists with modern, practical and clinical skills and high employment opportunities. Students study with the help of unique simulation laboratories and University clinics. They conduct researches on an individual and population level, publish articles. The program is collaborated between the University of Georgia and associated professors of American TAFTS University, along with the leading dentists. Modern literature in English and their online versions, are available with scientific articles provided in this program. The students have an opportunity to participate in scientific conferences, to publish their own research outcomes in UG journal - "Caucasus Journal of Health and Sciences and Public Health". International projects and Exchange Programs of the school are available for students. Practice is provided by the best multipurpose dental clinics of Health system under supervision of qualified mentors

The goal of the **single-cycle Medical program in English** is to coach competent, fair, experienced doctors, willing to broaden their knowledge constantly and gain new skills, ready to perform a function of a healer, a guardian, an educator, a scientist, a human rights defender, a leader etc., in order to promote health and well-being of local and global population. After finishing the study program, the student is certified with a qualification of an associate doctor. There are modern literature in English and their online versions, scientific articles provided in this program. The students have an opportunity to participate in scientific conferences, to publish their own research outcomes in UG journal - "Caucasus Journal of Health and Sciences and Public Health". International projects and Exchange Programs of the school are available for students. Practical training is provided by the best multipurpose dental clinics of Health system under supervision of qualified mentors.

The goal of the **Public Health PhD program in Georgian** is to coach a scientist with a wide profile in Public Health, able to create brand new knowledge within the field and understand and deepen the existing one, and thus contribute to the improvement of health and well-being of society. The graduate student of the PhD program will have a knowledge based on the latest achievements in Public Health and will be able to research the determiners of health by using innovative technologies, to evaluate the results of their management through modern methods, to develop and teach complex study modules of Public Health, to prepare scientific projects and implement them according to the latest managerial standards within the fields of public health. There is modern literature in English and their online versions, with scientific articles provided in this program. The students have an opportunity to participate in scientific conferences, to publish their own research outcomes in UG journal - "Caucasus Journal of Health and Sciences and Public Health".

There are International projects and Exchange Programs in USA, Norway, Turkey and various countries in Europe available for students. For example, students are using the best computer data.

# RESOURCES

## SIMULATION HOSPITAL



is one of the best multi-profile simulation laboratories in Georgia. It is the imitation of a hospital and is equipped with modern medical-teaching simulators as well as medical and multi-functional moulages. In this real-life environment the students master the following practical skills: patient care, injections, peripheral venous catheterization, bladder catheterization, draining, pulmonary and cardiac auscultation, wound treatment, emergency rescue, etc. The simulation hospital comprises three functional parts: manipulative, gynecological and hospital that includes its own auditorium. It is used on simulation patients/moulages for manipulation-procedures and accomplishing assignments of video records online.

## SIMULATION PHARMACY



is the simulation base of pharmacy program, where theoretical knowledge can be practically demonstrate. Situational assignments and clinical cases are conducted and reviewed at the simulation pharmacy, through role-playing (Pharmacist-patient pharmacist-doctor-patient, pharmacist-doctor-health care specialist, etc.) The Students design pharmaceutical case, comprising medical therapy, medical material, knowledge and use of pharmaceutical computer programs. The program provides understanding and evaluation of pharmaceutical case.

## OSCE HALL

is equipped with all the necessary dummies as well as with necessary reagents, soils, instruments and equipment for optical tests required for imagining and understanding of various processes and images.

## DENTAL SIMULATION

Practical Laboratory is the dentistry simulation practical laboratory where modern methods are used for developing practical skills. The students familiarize themselves with all the important aspects of dental service on special moulages; the students work at the multi-profile dental desk and devices that enable them to gain practical skills in the following areas: therapeutic, orthopedic, surgical and orthodontic dentistry. The laboratory is formed based on the experience of the University of Thompson and its quality gives it the top rating in the region.

## ANATOMY, BIOCHEMISTRY AND MICROBIOLOGY LABS



are equipped with the moulages, necessary for teaching topics, the optics and chemical agents, soils, tools, installations for the performance and understanding of the necessary processes.

## HEALTH RESEARCH INSTITUTE

Researches for public health, nursing, health administration and medicine are conducted here. The physical medicine and rehabilitation clinic of the University of Georgia provides medical and rehabilitation services using the newest technologies and methods.

## REAVITA UG - CLINIC FOR PHYSICAL MEDICINE AND REHABILITATION

The Clinic aims at improving patient's health conditions and ensures achievement of functional independence by means of various restorative and recreational procedures performed by qualified professionals. The clinic offers students the opportunity to obtain practical knowledge in the field of physical medicine and rehabilitation. Reavita operates in the following directions: rehabilitation-recreation; diagnostic-treatment; training, certificate programs.

The center works with local and international incubators and accelerators through introducing the promising projects to the local and international market.

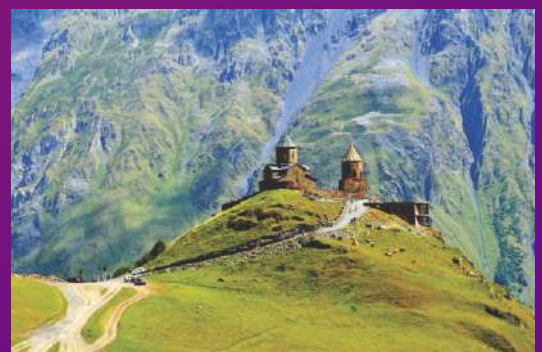
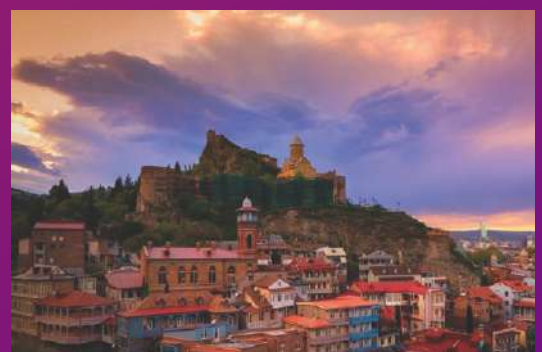
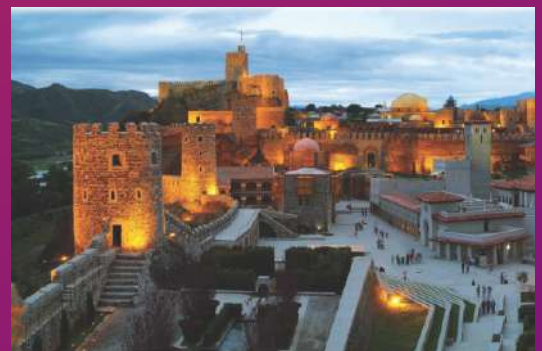
